What to know?

- This program is designed for non-U.S. citizens to earn an American Certified Public Accountant (CPA) license.
- Applicants must work with an American CPA firm to satisfy the required hours of supervised work experience. This experience can be completed remotely from the applicant's home country.
- Take the Uniform CPA Examination
 - To be eligible to sit for the Uniform CPA Examination—part of the U.S. CPA licensure process—your educational qualifications must meet the requirements of the state board. You must apply through a participating U.S. state board of accountancy.
 - The CPA Exam is administered at Prometric testing centers in select international locations.
